PREVAILING WAGE CERTIFICATION

Effective: January 2, 2014

In accordance with the intergovernmental agreement entered between the Illinois Department of Transportation (“IDOT”) and the Illinois Department of Labor (“IDOL”) and pursuant to the “Illinois Prevailing Wage Act” (820 ILCS 130 *et. seq.*), IDOT has requested IDOL to ascertain each craft or type of worker or mechanic needed to execute the work to be performed on the project and to certify the general prevailing rate of hourly wages for work under this contract, as required in the locality in which the work is to be performed. IDOL has certified the general prevailing rate of hourly wages for work under this contract.

In paragraph K of the Certifications (Apprenticeship and Training Certification), the bidder shall make certain that each type of work or craft that will be utilized on the project, as certified by IDOL, is accounted for and listed.
