SPECIAL PROVISIONS

The following Special Provision supplement the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction", adopted January 1, 2022, "Supplemental Specifications" adopted January 1, 2024, the latest edition of the "Illinois Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways", and the "Manual of Test Procedures for Materials" in effect on the date of invitation for bids and the Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions indicated on the Check Sheet included herein which apply to and govern the construction of Section 20-00116-00-PP in Hamilton County.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK

The proposed improvement shall consist of the construction of 18' - 23' wide Bituminous Surface Treatment on existing Oil and Chip roads for pavement preservation measures.

TRAFFIC CONTROL AND PROTECTION, (SPECIAL)

Traffic Control shall be in accordance with the applicable sections of the Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, the applicable guidelines contained in the Illinois Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, these special provisions, and any special details and Highway Standards contained herein and in the plans.

Special attention is called to Articles 107.09 and 107.14 of the Standard Specifications and the following Highway Standards: 701006, 701011, 701301, 701306, 701311 and 701901.

All costs for labor, material, and equipment necessary to furnish, install, maintain and remove all traffic control devices to perform the work for the duration of the project and as directed by the Engineer, shall be considered incidental to the contract and no additional compensation will be allowed.

UTILITIES

There are no known utilities within the limits of this improvement requiring adjustment. It shall be the Contractor's responsibility to determine the actual location of all such facilities, known or unknown.
