TRAFFIC CONTROL AND PROTECTION, STANDARD 701316 (SPECIAL)

<u>Description</u>. This work shall consist of providing all labor, equipment, and materials necessary to provide and maintain all traffic control and protection for the duration of the project as shown on the plans except for those items which are paid for separately.

This work will also include the setup, relocation, and removal of the traffic control, signage, and temporary signal layout for the one lane closures along IL 10 for the various stages.

The temporary traffic signals shall be post mounted only and must include video detection. Trailer mounted signals will not be allowed.

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
