

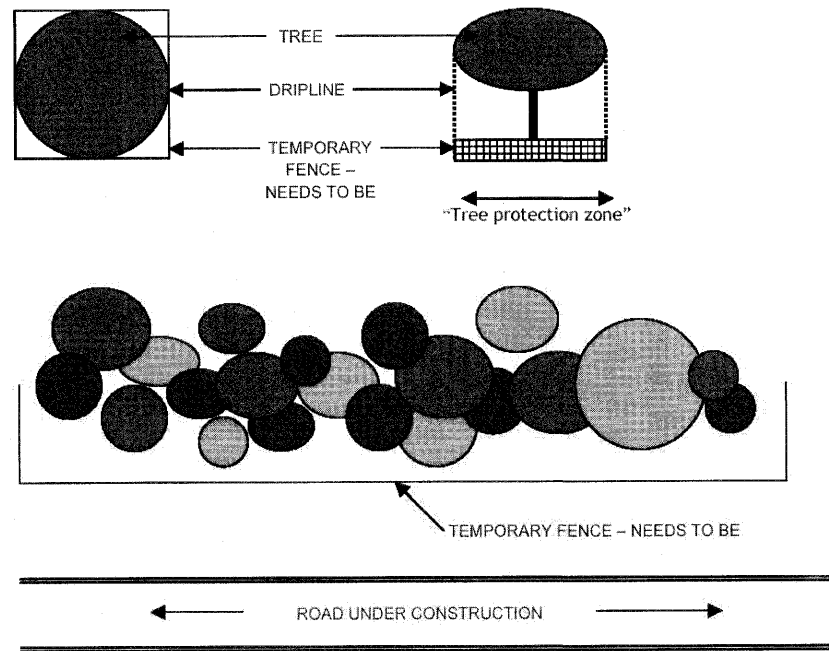
GENERAL NOTES

27. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PREPARE IN-STREAM WORK PLANS (ALL COFFERDAMS, WORK PADS AND EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL, ETC.) AND SUBMIT TO THE ENGINEER AND THE U.S. ARMY CORP OF ENGINEERS FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL. THE CONTRACTOR SHOULD EXPECT TO HAVE TO ATTEND MEETINGS AT THE USACE OFFICE TO DISCUSS THEIR WORK PLAN IN ORDER TO SECURE THEIR PERMIT. THE COST OF ALL IN-STREAM WORK ITEMS WILL NOT BE PAID FOR SEPARATELY, BUT SHALL BE CONSIDERED AS INCLUDED IN THE UNIT BID PRICES OF THE CONTRACT, AND NO ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION WILL BE ALLOWED.

28. THE CONTRACTOR'S ATTENTION IS CALLED TO THE FACT THAT THE PRESERVATION OF EXISTING TREES IS OF UTMOST IMPORTANCE TO THE CITY OF WARRENVILLE. ALL TREE PROTECTION, TREE REMOVAL, PRUNING AND ROOT PRUNING SHALL BE COMPLETED BEFORE CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS COMMENCE IN ANY AREA. AT NO TIME SHALL THE CONTRACTOR PRUNE OR REMOVE ANY TREES UNLESS SPECIFICALLY DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.

29. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL TAKE EXTRA CARE IN GRADING AND EXCAVATING NEAR TREES WHICH ARE NOT MARKED FOR REMOVAL SO AS NOT TO CAUSE INJURY TO THE ROOT SYSTEM OR TRUNKS. HAND EXCAVATION SHALL BE PERFORMED IF MAJOR ROOTS ARE PRESENT. MAJOR ROOTS OF A TREE THAT ARE TO REMAIN IN PLACE EXTENDING INTO THE EXCAVATION AREAS AT AN ELEVATION THAT WOULD INTERFERE WITH ANY PORTION OF THE PLANNED CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE SEVERED AT A POINT IMMEDIATELY OUTSIDE OF THE EXCAVATION AREA IN A MANNER THAT WILL CAUSE THE LEAST AMOUNT OF SYSTEMIC TO THE REMAINING TREE STRUCTURE. THE EXPENSE OF ANY REQUIRED HAND EXCAVATION AND/OR THE CUTTING OF MAJOR TREE ROOTS, AS DESCRIBED ABOVE, SHALL BE CONSIDERED INCIDENTAL TO THE CONTRACT LINE ITEM BEING REMOVED OR INSTALLED AT THAT LOCATION. ANY DAMAGE DONE TO EXISTING ITEMS BY THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE REPAIRED BY THE CONTRACTOR AT THE CONTRACTOR'S OWN EXPENSE.

30. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ERECT A TEMPORARY FENCE AROUND ALL TREES WITHIN THE CONSTRUCTION AREA TO ESTABLISH A "TREE PROTECTION ZONE" AND AROUND EXISTING WETLANDS TO ESTABLISH A "WETLAND PROTECTION ZONE" BEFORE ANY WORK BEGINS OR ANY MATERIAL IS DELIVERED TO THE JOBSITE. NO WORK IS TO BE PERFORMED (OTHER THAN ROOT PRUNING), MATERIALS STORED OR VEHICLES DRIVEN OR PARKED WITHIN THE "TREE PROTECTION ZONE" AND "WETLAND PROTECTION ZONE". REMOVE PROTECTIVE TEMPORARY FENCE ONLY AFTER ALL CONSTRUCTION WORK HAS BEEN COMPLETED. SEE DETAIL BELOW.

GENERAL NOTES (CONTINUED)

31. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ATTACH AN ALUMINUM SIGN WITH THE FOLLOWING TEXT: PROTECTED WETLAND - NO INTRUSION. THE SIGN(S) SHALL BE ATTACHED TO THE STAKES BY A METHOD APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER. THE SIGN(S) WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT AND SHALL BE PICKED UP BY THE CONTRACTOR FROM THE DISTRICT ONE ROADSIDE DEVELOPMENT ARCHITECT IN SCHAUMBURG, ILLINOIS. SCHEDULING THE PICKUP OF THE SIGNS CAN BE ARRANGED BY CONTACTING THE DISTRICT ONE ROADSIDE DEVELOPMENT UNIT AT (847)705-4171. WHEN WORK HAS BEEN COMPLETED, THE SIGN SHALL BE RETURNED TO THE DISTRICT ONE ROADSIDE DEVELOPMENT UNIT. THE COST OF PICKING UP, ATTACHING THE SIGNS TO THE TEMPORARY FENCE STAKES AND RETURNING THE SIGNS WILL NOT BE PAID FOR SEPARATELY, BUT SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE CONTRACT UNIT PRICE FOR TEMPORARY FENCE.

32. THE SEEDING DATES FOR BARE EARTH SEEDING OF MIXTURE CLASS 4A, 4B, 5A (MODIFIED), AND WETLAND MIX SHALL BE FROM NOVEMBER 15 TO MARCH 15. ALL SEEDING NOT SOWN ACCORDING TO THE SPECIFIED SEASONAL DATE SHALL REQUIRE PRIOR WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM THE ENGINEER. FAILURE TO SECURE SUCH APPROVAL SHALL RESULT IN THE REJECTION OF THE SEEDING AND REPLACEMENT BY THE CONTRACTOR AT HIS/HER EXPENSE.

33. THE SEEDING DATES FOR BARE EARTH SEEDING OF MIXTURE CLASS 2A SHALL BE FROM APRIL 1 TO JUNE 1 AND FROM AUGUST 15 TO SEPTEMBER 30. ALL SEEDING NOT SOWN ACCORDING TO THE SPECIFIED SEASONAL DATE SHALL REQUIRE PRIOR WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM THE ENGINEER. FAILURE TO SECURE SUCH APPROVAL SHALL RESULT IN THE REJECTION OF THE SEEDING AND REPLACEMENT BY THE CONTRACTOR AT HIS/HER EXPENSE.

34. THE ENGINEER WILL CONTACT FABIOLA QUIROZ OF THE ROADSIDE DEVELOPMENT UNIT AT (847) 705-4596, AT LEAST 7 DAYS PRIOR TO PLANTING FOR LAYOUT OF THE SEEDING, TREES, SHRUBS, VINES PERENNIALS, AND PLUGS.

35. THE GENERAL CONTRACTOR IS REQUIRED TO HIRE AN ENVIRONMENTAL FIRM WITH AT LEAST FIVE (5) DOCUMENTED LEAKING UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANKS (LUST) CLEANUPS OR THAT IS PRE-QUALIFIED IN HAZARDOUS WASTE BY THE DEPARTMENT TO REMEDIATE THE SOIL CONTAMINATION AND MONITOR FOR WORKER PROTECTION.

COMMITMENTS

1. THE SECTION OF ILLINOIS PRAIRIE PATH WITHIN THE PROJECT LIMITS SHOULD BE KEPT OPEN AT ALL TIMES DURING CONSTRUCTION.
2. THE GRAMINOID SEEP, LOCATED NORTH OF THE ILLINOIS ROUTE 56 BRIDGE OVER THE WEST BRANCH OF THE DuPAGE RIVER (LOCATED WITHIN WETLAND #7) IS CONSIDERED TO BE REGIONALLY NOTEWORTHY AND WILL BE AVOIDED BY THE PROJECT.
3. A COMMITMENT WAS PROVIDED IN PHASE I TO PROVIDE "COUNT DOWN" PEDESTRIAN TIMERS AT CROSSWALK LOCATIONS THROUGHOUT THE PROJECT. IN ADDITION, AT LOCATIONS WHERE EQUESTRIAN CROSSINGS ARE PROVIDED FOR USING THE APPROPRIATE PAVEMENT STRIPING, EQUESTRIAN HEIGHT CALL BUTTONS WILL BE PROVIDED AS WELL.
4. AT FERRY CREEK, THERE IS AN EXISTING 21" CITY OF WARRENVILLE SANITARY SEWER THAT IS NEAR THE PROPOSED BOX CULVERT AND DOES NOT HAVE MUCH COVER RELATIVE TO THE BOTTOM OF THE PROPOSED BOX CULVERT. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL HAND EXCAVATE NEAR THIS SEWER AND SHALL NOT RUN HEAVY EQUIPMENT ON TOP OF THIS SEWER.
