**PLUG DRAIN DETAIL**



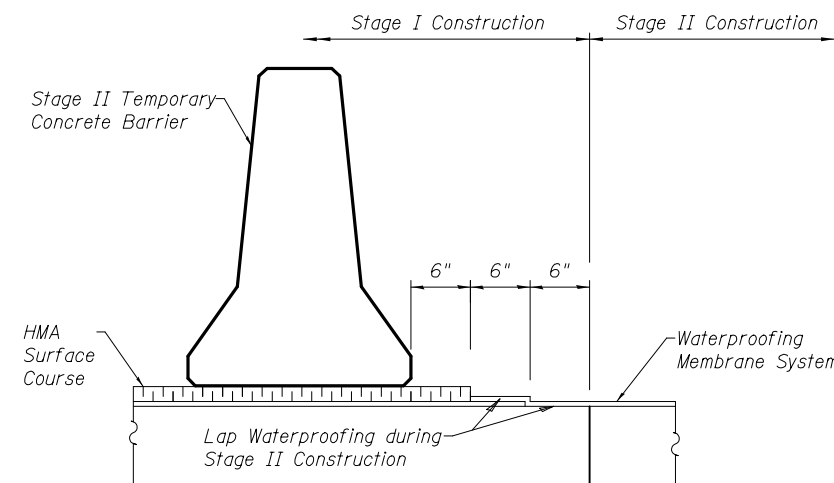
