

Existing neoprene expansion -joint is to be removed and

replaced in kind, full width.

to construction or ordering of materials. Such variations shall not be cause for additional compensation for a change in scope of the work, however, the Contractor will be paid for the quantity actually furnished at the unit price bid for the work.

Joint plates and attached bars shall be shop painted with the inorganic zinc rich primer. No field paint required.

Existing reinforcement bars extending into the removal area shall be cleaned, straightened and incorporated into the new construction. Any reinforcement bars that are damaged during concrete removal shall be replaced with an approved bar splicer or anchorage system.

Cost included with Concrete Removal. Joint openings shall be adjusted according to Article 520.04 of the Std. Specs. when the deck is poured at an ambient temperature other than 50° F.
