GENERAL NOTES

CONTRACT NO. 62866

BEFORE STARTING ANY EXCAVATION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CALL "J.U.L.I.E." AT (800) 892-0123 FOR FIELD LOCATIONS OF BURIED ELECTRIC, TELEPHONE AND GAS UTILITIES. (48 HOUR NOTIFICATION IS REQUIRED). IN CHICAGO, CALL "C.U.A.N." (CHICAGO UTILITY ALERT NETWORK) AT (312)744-7000 FOR FIELD LOCATIONS OF BURIED ELECTRIC, TELEPHONE AND GAS UTILITIES. (48 HOUR NOTIFICATION IS REQUIRED).

DO NOT SCALE PLANS FOR CONSTRUCTION DIMENSIONS

THE CONTRACTOR WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SET UP A YARD OR FIELD OFFICE ON STATE PROPERTY WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM THE DEPARTMENT.

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONTACT THE DISTRICT ONE TRAFFIC CONTROL SUPERVISOR AT (847) 705-4151 OR 4155 FOR EXPRESSWAYS A MINIMUM OF 72 HOURS IN ADVANCE OF BEGINNING WORK.

THESE PLANS HAVE BEEN PREPARED FROM NOTES RECEIVED FROM BRIDGE INSPECTORS.

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE AWARE THAT SOME LOCATIONS HAVE UTILITY CONDUITS. ANY DAMAGE TO THE CONDUITS CAUSED BY THE CONTRACTOR'S OPERATIONS SHALL BE REPLACED OR REPAIRED BY THE CONTRACTOR AT THEIR EXPENSE. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ADJUST THE PROTECTIVE SHIELDING TO FIT AROUND THE CONDUITS. DETAILS SHALL BE APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER BEFORE INSTALLATION. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES WITH UTILITY COMPANIES.

PLAN DIMENSIONS AND DETAILS RELATIVE TO EXISTING STRUCTURE HAVE BEEN TAKEN FROM EXISTING PLANS AND ARE SUBJECT TO NOMINAL CONSTRUCTION VARIATIONS. IT SHALL BE THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY SUCH DIMENSIONS AND DETAILS IN THE FIELD AND MAKE NECESSARY APPROVED ADJUSTMENTS PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION OR ORDERING OF MATERIALS. SUCH VARIATIONS SHALL NOT BE CAUSE FOR ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION FOR A CHANGE IN THE SCOPE OF THE WORK, HOWEVER, THE CONTRACTOR WILL BE PAID FOR THE QUANTITY ACTUALLY FURNISHED AT THE UNIT PRICE BID FOR THE WORK.

WHEN ARTIFICIAL LIGHTING IS UTILIZED IN NIGHT OPERATIONS, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL EXERCISE THE UTMOST PRECAUTIONS IN PREVENTING ADVERSE VISIBILITY TO THE MOTORING PUBLIC AND ADJOINING RESIDENTIAL AREAS.

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ADJUST THE PROTECTIVE SHIELDING TO RIDE ABOVE THE EXISTING LIGHTING FIXTURES. IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN THE EXISTING LEVEL OF LIGHTING OF THE ROADWAY UNDERNEATH. DETAILS SHALL BE APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER BEFORE INSTALLATION.
