





## GENERAL NOTES

PLAN DIMENSIONS AND DETAILS RELATIVE TO EXISTING PLANS ARE SUBJECT TO ROUTINE VARIATIONS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL FIELD VERIFY EXISTING DIMENSIONS AND DETAILS AFFECTING NEW CONSTRUCTION AND MAKE NECESSARY APPROVED ADJUSTMENTS PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION OR ORDERING OF MATERIALS. SUCH VARIATIONS SHALL NOT BE CAUSE FOR ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION FOR A CHANGE IN THE SCOPE OF THE WORK. HOWEVER, THE CONTRACTOR WILL BE PAID FOR THE QUANTITY FURNISHED BASED UPON THE UNIT BID FOR THE WORK.

FOR STABILIZATION, ALL TYPE III BARRICADES SHALL REQUIRE A MINIMUM OF FOUR SAND BAGS PER BARRICADE.

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROTECTING UTILITY PROPERTY FROM CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS AS OUTLINED IN ARTICLE 107.31 OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS. THE "JULIE" NUMBER IS 1-800-892-0123. A MINIMUM OF FORTY-EIGHT (48) HOURS ADVANCE NOTICE IS REQUIRED.

ANY REFERENCE TO A STANDARD IN THESE PLANS SHALL BE INTERPRETED TO MEAN THE EDITION AS INDICATED BY THE SUBNUMBER LISTED ON THE INDEX OF SHEETS OR THE COPY OF THE STANDARD INCLUDED IN THESE PLANS.

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE REQUIRED TO SECURE WASTE CONTAINERS THAT REMAIN ON THE JOB SITE. THIS WILL ENTAIL THAT ALL WASTE CONTAINERS CAN NOT BE MOVED OR OPENED DURING NON-WORKING HOURS.

WORKING DAYS SHALL BE CHARGED UNTIL THE CONTRACTOR/ SUBCONTRACTOR LICENSED TO DISPOSE OF LEAD PAINT RESIDUE HAS REMOVED THE WASTE MATERIAL FROM THE JOB SITE ACCORDING TO ALL FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL LAWS AND ORDINANCES.

THE EXISTING STEEL CONTAINS LEAD. THE CONTRACTOR SHOULD TAKE APPROPRIATE PRECAUTIONS TO DEAL WITH THE PRESENSE OF LEAD PAINT ON THIS PROJECT. EXISTING PAINT COATINGS SHALL NOT BE DISTURBED OR REMOVED.

THE SSPC-OP1 AND SSPC-OP2 PAINTING CONTRACTOR CERTICATIONS WILL BE REQUIRED FOR THIS PROJECT.

THE CLEANING AND PAINTING OF THE EXISTING STEEL SHALL BE AS SPECIFIED IN THE SPECIAL PROVISION FOR "CLEANING AND PAINTING EXISTING STEEL BUILDINGS".

ALL EXISTING EXTERIOR STEEL, INCLUDING WALLS, DOORS, TRIM WORK, CUTTERS AND ROOFS SHALL BE CLEANED PER "LOW PRESSURE WATER CLEANING" SSPC-SPI2. ALL EXISTING EXTERIOR STEEL INCLUDING WALLS, DOORS, TRIM WORK GUTTERS AND ROOFS SHALL BE PAINTED WITH AN APPROVED CALVANIZED METAL PRIMER OR ACRYLIC PRIMER SUITABLE FOR METAL AND TWO (2) COATS OF AN APPROVED "ACRYLIC PAINT". THE COLOR OF THE FINAL FINISH COAT FOR DOORS, WINDOWS AND ROOFS SHALL BE "WHITE". THE FINAL FINISH COAT FOR ALL TRIM WORK SHALL BE DARK BROWN. ALL PAINT MATERIALS SHALL BE APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER PRIOR TO THE ORDERING OF MATERIALS.

ALL EXISTING EXTERIOR STEEL INCLUDING WALLS, DOORS, TRIM WORK, GUTTERS INCLUDING DOWN SPOUTS, AND ROOF EAVES SHALL BE CLEANED ACCORDING TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF SSPC-SP1 AND SSPC-SP2 (SSI-ST3). ALL EXISTING EXTERIOR STEEL INCLUDING WALLS, DOORS, TRIM WORK, GUTTERS INCLUDING DOWN SPOUTS, AND ROOF EAVES SHALL BE PAINTED WITH ONE (1) APPLICATION OF A "LOW FILM ACRYLIC INHIBITING PRIMER" SUITABLE FOR METAL SURFACES AND TWO (2) APPLICATIONS OF AN INDUSTRIAL "SPRAY SAFE" ACRYLIC PAINT.


