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A ½-inch thick expansion joint shall be provided at the junction of the PCC driveway apron and curb, and at the junction of the PCC driveway apron and sidewalk.

Replacement of existing HMA driveway shall be constructed to match the thickness of the existing pavement removed; however, the minimum thickness and HMA items shall be as shown on District 1 BD-01/02 "Driveway Details" detail.

Replacement of existing PCC driveway shall be in accordance with Section 423 of the Standard Specifications. It shall be constructed to match the thickness of the existing pavement removed; however, the minimum thickness shall be as shown on District 1 BD-01/02 "Driveway Details" detail.

<u>Method of Measurement.</u> This work will be measured for payment in place and the area computed in square yards.

<u>Basis of Payment.</u> This work will be paid for at the contract unit price per SQUARE YARD for DRIVEWAY SURFACE REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT, of the thickness specified.

REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF REGULATED SUBSTANCES (PROJECT SPECIFIC)

<u>Description</u>. This work shall consist of the removal and disposal of regulated substances according to Section 669 of the Standard Specifications as revised below.

<u>Contract Specific Sites</u>. For stationing, the lateral distance is measured from centerline and the farthest distance is the offset distance or construction limit, whichever is less.

The following contract specific work areas shall be monitored by the environmental firm for soil contamination and workers protection.

<u>Intersection of Wilke Road and Victoria Drive, Palatine, Cook County.</u> All excavation planned at the northwest quadrant, northwest island, southwest island, and southwest quadrant at the intersection of Wilke Road and Victoria Drive. The Engineer has determined this material meets the criteria of and shall be managed in accordance with Article 669.05(a)(1). Potential contaminants of concern sampling parameters: VOCs, SVOCs and Metals.

Intersection of Wilke Road and Lake Louise Condominium Entrance Drive (north entrance), Palatine, Cook County. All excavation planned at the northwest quadrant, and southwest quadrant at the intersection of Wilke Road and Lake Louise Condominium Entrance Drive (north entrance). The Engineer has determined this material meets the criteria of and shall be managed in accordance with Article 669.05(a)(1). Potential contaminants of concern sampling parameters: VOCs, SVOCs and Metals.

Intersection of Wilke Road and Lake Louise Condominium Entrance Drive (south entrance), Palatine, Cook County. All excavation planned at the northwest quadrant, and southwest quadrant at the intersection of Wilke Road and Lake Louise Condominium Entrance Drive (south entrance). The Engineer has determined this material meets the criteria of and shall be managed in accordance with Article 669.05(a)(1). Potential contaminants of concern sampling parameters: VOCs, SVOCs and Metals.

Intersection of Wilke Road and Anderson Drive, Palatine, Cook County. All excavation planned at the southeast quadrant at the intersection of Wilke Road and Anderson Drive. The Engineer has determined this material meets the criteria of and shall be managed in accordance with Article 669.05(a)(1). Potential contaminants of concern sampling parameters: VOCs, SVOCs and Metals.

<u>Work Zones.</u> Three distinct OSHA HAZWOPER work zones (exclusion, decontamination, and support) shall apply to projects adjacent to or within sites with documented leaking underground storage tank (LUST) incidents, or sites under management in accordance with the requirements of the Site Remediation Program (SRP), Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), or Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA), or as deemed necessary. For this project, the work zones apply for the following ISGS PESA Sites: None
