REMOVAL OF EXISTING STRUCTURES

The removal and satisfactory disposal of existing SN 051-0009 shall be according to Section 501 of the Standard Specifications and as described in the plans. The work shall include the staged removal of the steel bridge rail, wearing surface, superstructure, approach spans, and all four concrete wing walls. The sequence of removal shall be as detailed in the structure plans.

All work described shall be paid for at the contract unit price per EACH for REMOVAL OF EXISTING STRUCTURES with no additional compensation. The quantity of each shall include both stage I and stage II removal.

SEEDING, CLASS 2 (SPECIAL)

All areas disturbed during construction shall be seeded with class 2 seeding in accordance with Section 250 of the Standard Specifications. All disturbed areas shall be covered with mulch in accordance with Section 251 of the Standard Specifications. The Contractor shall use method 1.

This work will be paid for at the contract unit price per ACRE for SEEDING, CLASS 2 (SPECIAL), which price shall include furnishing and applying fertilizer nutrients at the rate of 90 lbs./acre for Nitrogen, Phosphorus, and Potassium; at the rate of 4 tons/acre for agricultural ground limestone; and at the rate of 2 tons/acre for mulch.
