Justification for use of project Labor Agreement on Contract 70C01 Champaign County:

The use of a project Labor Agreement on this project is consistent with all State and Local statutory regulatory requirements.

Project Description: This project is fourth of four projects associated with the reconstruction of the FAI 57 and FAI 74 interchange in Champaign County. The project consists of pavement reconstruction, lane additions, new structures, noise wall, earthwork, guardrail, and lighting. Other improvements associated with the project include pavement marking and raised reflective pavement markers.

- Item 3: Estimated project cost is \$91,000,000. The use of a PLA will assure the project will be completed efficiently.
- Item 4: The project is on the April 29, 2022 letting. Construction activities will continue through 2024. The project has an estimated 290 working days.
- **Item 6:** Carpenters Local 243's contract expires 4/30/2022. Cement Masons Local 143's contract expires 04/30/2022. Teamsters Local 26's contract expires 04/30/2022. Iron Workers local 380's contract expires 4/30/2024. IBEW Local 601's contract expires 3/3/2024. Laborers local 703's contract expires 4/30/2023.
- Item 8: Any disruption to the contractor's schedule due to labor issues may result in an increase in duration of the project. This, in turn, would increase the length of time the traffic control on I-57 and I74 will be in place. The district desires to minimize the length of time traffic control is on I-57 and I-74 to reduce the potential for crashes and improve safety.
