Tree Protection Detail N.T.S.

Tree Removal Notes

- 1. All stumps to be ground to min. 12" below finished grade.
- 2. No grinding or mulch to be reused anywhere on the project boundaries.
- Contractor will be responsible for properly protecting all pedestrian, vehicular and building areas from tree removal debris.
- 4. Field verify all trees to be removed with Landscape Architect.

Demolition Notes

- 1. Remove all debris and legally dispose of off site.
- 2. Remove raised planters including any footings, foundations and/or topsoil.
- 3. Remove concrete banding and banding base/sub-base courses.
- All signs to be removed shall be salvaged and stored in the owner's facility for future use as applicable.
- 5. Contractor shall keep all city streets free and clear of construction relate dirt/dust/debris.
- All sawcutting shall be full depth to provide a clean edge to match new construction, match existing elevations at points of connection for new and existing pavement, curb, sidewalks, etc.
- All sawcut locations shown are approximate and may be field adjusted to accommodate conditions, joints, material type, etc. remove minimum amount necessary for installation of proposed improvements.
- Contractor shall provide traffic flagger as necessary during demolition and construction operations on or near the public roadway.
- All light poles to be removed shall be removed in their entirety, including base and all
 appurtenances. coordinate abandonment of electrical lines with electrical engineer and owner prior
 to demolition.
- 10. Within project limits remove or abandon existing utility services as necessary to facilitate new work. coordinate with local authorities and utility companies having jurisdiction.
- 11. All utilities to remain outside of project limits.
- 12. Coordinate with surrounding owners to remove any existing moveable planters/seating dividers.
