THE RESIDENT ENGINEER SHALL CONTACT MR. LAWRENCE HILL AREA TRAFFIC FIELD ENGINEER AT (847) 846-2165 A MINIMUM OF 2 WEEKS PRIOR TO PLACEMENT OF PERMANENT PAVEMENT MARKING.

THE RESIDENT ENGINEER SHALL VERIFY ALL EXISTING PAVEMENT MARKINGS BEFORE PERFORMING ANY ACTIVITY ON THE PAVEMENT.

DO NOT SCALE PLANS FOR CONSTRUCTION DIMENSIONS

DOUBLE LANE MARKERS ARE TO BE USED AS SHOWN ON THE DISTRICT ONE DETAIL "TYPICAL APPLICATIONS - RAISED REFLECTIVE PAVEMENT MARKERS (SNOW-PLOW RESISTANT)" SHOWN IN THE PLANS.

IT SHALL BE THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY ALL DIMENSIONS AND CONDITIONS EXISTING IN THE FIELD PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION AND ORDERING OF MATERIALS.

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONTACT THE DISTRICT ONE TRAFFIC CONTROL SUPERVISOR AT (847) 705-4470 A MINIMUM OF 72 HOURS IN ADVANCE OF BEGINNING WORK.

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE ACCESS TO ABUTTING PROPERTY AT ALL TIMES DURING THE CONSTRUCTION OF THIS PROJECT.
