Justification for use of project Labor Agreement on Contract 74959 Macon County:

The use of a project Labor Agreement on this project is consistent with all State and Local statutory regulatory requirements.

Project Description: This project is for the resurfacing of FAP 323(US 36) from 0.4 mi east of Airport Rd in Decatur to 0.2 mi west of ILL 32. Other improvements associated with the project include paving, patching, milling, traffic control and pavement marking.
