Justification for use of Project Labor Agreement on Contract 66L88 Kankakee County:

The use of a project Labor Agreement on this project is consistent with all State and Local statutory regulatory requirements.

Project Description:

This is a 3P milling and resurfacing project. The work consists of milling at 3.75" and resurfacing with 2.25" HMA Binder and 1.50" of HMA surface course. The project also includes ADA improvement within the Village of Bourbonnais and traffic signal modernization at the intersection of Career Center Rd, Briarcliff Ln, WM Latham Sr Dr, Stratford Dr, and Brown Blvd. The project length extends on IL 102 from the Will County Line to US 45/52.

Item 3:

Estimated project cost is \$5,575,000. Any disruption in the continuity of this project due to labor issues would result in the delay of deadlines which would cause safety concerns for the travelling public. Lapsing trade contracts during the project duration would be addressed through use of a Project Labor Agreement. It is the Illinois Department of Transportation's finding that the large skilled workforce needed for this project can be provided by union trades involved and is a necessary requirement for a Project Labor Agreement.

Item 8:

Any disruption to the contractor's schedule due to labor issues may result in an increase in duration of the project. Along with the high ADT this, in turn, would increase the length of time the traffic control on IL 102 will be in place. Item 9:
