### CONTRACTOR ACCESS


At road closure locations, where Type III barricades are installed in a manner that will not allow Contractor access to the project without relocation of one or more of the barricades, the arrangement of the barricades at the beginning of each work day may be relocated, when approved by the Engineer, in the manner shown on Highway Standard 701901. At the end of each work day, the barricades shall be returned to the proper overnight position.

The cost incurred by the Contractor in complying with this requirement shall be considered included in the contract unit price bid for traffic control work and no additional compensation will be allowed.

### EARTH EXCAVATION

This work shall be constructed according to Section 202 of the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction," except as modified herein:

At locations where existing bituminous treated surface lies at or below the elevation of the proposed subgrade, the Contractor shall scarify the existing surface, reducing all particles to a size not larger than four inches in the largest dimension and recompact the existing surface prior to placing earth embankment or other subbase material.

 ~~All excavated material shall be used on site. No material shall be hauled away unless approved by the Engineer.~~

This work will be paid for at the contract unit price per cubic yard for EARTH EXCAVATION, measured as specified in Article 202.07 of the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction", as specified herein and no additional compensation will be allowed.

### TRENCH BACKFILL

This work shall be constructed according to Section 208 of the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction", except as modified herein:

Fine aggregate according to Article 1003.04 may be used for bedding only, except as follows: Fine aggregate will be required for trench backfill within 2-feet of all gas mains and gas service lines that are exposed during trenching operations.
