The ORIGINAL and one copy of the Substance Abuse Prevention Program Certification (FORM BC 261) shall be submitted to the District at the IDOT Preconstruction Conference.

The Contractor is required to follow submittal procedures as provided by the EEO Officer at the preconstruction conference and to follow all revisions to those procedures as issued thereafter.

If a report is rejected, it is the Contractor's responsibility to make required adjustments and/or corrections and resubmit the report. Reports not submitted and accepted within the established timeframes will be considered late.

Disclosure of this information is necessary to accomplish the statutory purpose as outlined under 23CFR part 230 and 41CFR part 60.4 and the Illinois Human Rights Act. Disclosure of this information is REQUIRED. Failure to comply with this special provision may result in the withholding of payments to the Contractor and/or cancellation, termination, or suspension of the contract in whole or part.

This special provision must be included in each subcontract agreement.

Compliance with this special provision shall be included in the cost of the contract, and no additional compensation will be allowed for any costs incurred.

GUARDRAIL REMOVAL

Effective: February 11, 1981 Revised: November 1, 2006

This work shall be done in accordance with Section 632 of the Standard Specifications, except as herein modified.

The salvaged material shall be hauled to the ______ Sector Maintenance Yard for storage.

Basis Of Payment: This work will be paid for at the contract unit price per FOOT for GUARDRAIL REMOVAL.



This work will be paid for at the contract unit price per LUMP SUM for WIDTH RESTRICTION SIGNING.

PLUG EXISTING INLETS

This work shall be to plug existing inlets at the locations shown on the plans.

Equipment: The equipment used shall be subject to the approval of the Engineer and shall allow for the Contractor to effectively fill the existing inlets with controlled low strength material mix 1 or a concrete mix approved by the Engineer prior to the beginning of construction. The method for plugging the inlets to allow the material to be used for filling the existing inlet shall be the responsibility of the Contractor.

<u>Construction Requirements:</u> <u>Sidewalks, curbs, drains, reinforcement, and/or existing transverse and longitudinal joints which are to remain in place shall be protected from damage during operations.</u> All damage caused by the Contractor shall be corrected, at the Contractor's expense, to the satisfaction of the Engineer.

The Contractor shall control the use of the material used for filling the existing inlets to ensure it does not overflow or be spilled onto the bridge deck or pavement.

The filling of the inlets shall be done in a manner that allows the fill material to reach set prior to filling the inlet with concrete used for concrete structures to create a curb at the inlet.

Method of Measurement. The work will be measured per each. No additional payment will be made.

Basis of Payment: This work will be paid for at the contract unit price per EACH for PLUG EXISTING INLETS.

BRIDGE DECK SCARIFICATION 1 1/2"

This work shall also include the scarification of the existing deck 1½" to expose the top mat of reinforcement, partial depth patching, and surface preparations to the specifications and in accordance with plan details.

<u>Equipment:</u> The equipment used shall be subject to the approval of the Engineer and shall meet the following requirements:

- (a) Surface Preparation Equipment. Surface preparation equipment shall be according to the applicable portions of Section 1100 and the following:
 - (1) Sawing Equipment. Sawing equipment shall be a concrete saw capable of sawing concrete to the specified depth.
 - (2) Mechanical Blast Cleaning Equipment. Mechanical blast cleaning may be performed by high-pressure waterblasting or shotblasting. Mechanical blast cleaning equipment
