Dear Joseph E. Crowe:

This is in response to your request for authorization for scour countermeasures around piers of the bridge structure of FAI 74 over Middle Fork Vermillion River. This project is located approximately 2.5 miles east of Oakwood, Vermillion County Illinois. The information supplied by you was reviewed to determine whether a Department of the Army (DA) permit will be required under the provisions of Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.

Your project is considered maintenance of a structure which has been previously authorized, either by DA Permit or by having been constructed prior to current Federal laws. Therefore, the project is authorized under the provisions of 33 CFR 330 Nationwide Permit (NWP) No. 3, Maintenance, as published in the Federal Register March 12, 2007. Under the provisions of this authorization you must comply with:

- (1) The enclosed Terms for Nationwide Permit No. 3 and the Nationwide Permit General Conditions.
- (2) The fifteen (15) specific terms and conditions outlined by National Park Service (NPS) in a letter dated 10-June-2009 to Mr. Charles J. Ingersoll (IDOT) by Stephen E. Adams (NPS).
- (3) You must also obtain an individual State 401 Water Quality Certification (WQC) or waiver from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency.

This decision is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter.  
**The enclosed Compliance Certification should be signed and returned when the project is completed.** If your project is not completed within this 2-year period or if your project is modified, you must contact us for another permit determination.
