PLAN PREPARATION MEMORANDUM 60-04

BACKGROUND AND PROCEDURE

This memorandum revises Plan Preparation Memorandum 83-139.P, Inlet Location Near Entrances and supplements Chapters 34 & 40 of the BDE Manual and Chapter 8 of the Drainage Manual in providing uniformity and consistency of inlet placement. In urban sections with curb and gutter, the designer should consider placing an inlet immediately upgrade from entrances when possible, especially where the entrance has a negative grade away from the pavement. The placement of these inlets should be considered in the overall inlet spacing throughout the curb & gutter limits.

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
