LIGHT POLE FOUNDATION, 30" DIAMETER, (SPECIAL)

This work shall be done in accordance with Section 836 of the Standard Specifications insofar as applicable and as detailed on the Plans.

The conduit used in the foundation shall be PVC conduit as detailed on the Plans.

<u>Basis of Payment</u>. This work will be paid for at the contract unit price per FOOT for LIGHT POLE FOUNDATION, 30" DIAMETER, (SPECIAL), which price shall be payment in full for all labor, equipment, materials, and incidental expenses as necessary to complete the work as specified.

MAINTENANCE OF EXISTING LIGHTING SYSTEM COMPLETE

This work consists of locating all conduit and wiring and maintaining the existing lighting system throughout the various stages of construction until the permanent power distribution is completed to the new pole light on the west side of IL 5 on IL 92 and the existing lights within this lighting system. The existing lighting system includes three circuits as shown on the plans. It shall also be the contractor's responsibility to provide any required temporary power feeds to maintain the existing lighting system during the bridge deck replacement. Therefore, some type of temporary power feed must be provided during varies stages of construction. This work shall conform to Section 801 of the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction" and shall be subject to review and approval by the District 2 Bureau of Operations.

This item shall be paid for at the contract unit price lump sum for MAINTENANCE OF EXISTING LIGHTING SYSTEM COMPLETE, which price shall be payment in full for furnishing the labor and equipment as described above.

REMOVE AND REINSTALL LIGHTING UNIT

This work shall consist of removing an existing light pole with luminaire and reinstalling on the new light pole foundation at the location determined by the Resident Engineer.

The Contractor shall remove the existing lighting unit as indicated on the plans, protect the existing foundation and wiring, keep the existing lighting system operational and reinstalling the lighting unit on the proposed foundation, making all the necessary connections to place the units back into operation.

The Contractor is responsible for providing a secure place for storage while area is under construction.

The Contractor shall be responsible for replacing any damaged components during the removal, storage or reinstallation of the units.
