THE COST OF ANY EXCAVATION OR BUSH REMOVAL SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE COST OF SAND MODULE IMPACT ATTENUATORS.

EXISTING PIPE UNDERDRAIN OUTLETS AND DRAINAGE STRUCTURES IN THE MEDIAN SLOPES SHALL BE PRESERVED AND PROTECTED DURING CONSTRUCTION. ANY DAMAGE TO AN UNDERDRAIN OUTLET RESULTING FROM CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY SHALL BE REPAIRED AT THE CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE.

IN ADDITION TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF ARTICLE 107.16. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROTECT THE SURFACE OF ALL BRIDGE DECKS AND BRIDGE APPROACH PAVEMENTS IN A MANNER SATISFACTORY TO THE ENGINEER BEFORE ANY EQUIPMENT IS ALLOWED TO CROSS THE STRUCTURE. PROTECTION SHALL BE PROVIDED FOR ALL EQUIPMENT AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 107.16 REGARDLESS IF TRACK MOUNTED OR WHEFLED

TWO APPLICATIONS OF TEMPORARY EROSION CONTROL SEEDING HAVE BEEN INCLUDED. THE ACTUAL QUANTITY, LOCATIONS, AND APPLICATIONS SHALL BE AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER. THE APPLICATION RATE SHALL BE AS PER ARTICLE 280.04(f).

REVISE THE FIRST SENTENCE OF ARTICLE 107.09 PUBLIC CONVINIENCE AND SAFETY TO THE FOLLOWING "THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE ENGINEER AT LEAST 14 DAYS IN ADVANCE OF STARTING ANY CONSTRUCTION WORK. THIS ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IS REQUIRED SO THAT THE PUBLIC CAN BE NOTIFIED OF THE PENDING CONSTRUCTION."
