## **PLAN PREPARATION MEMORANDUM 60-04**

In urban sections with curb and gutter, the designer should consider placing an inlet immediately updrift from entrances. This is especially important where the entrance has a negative grade away from the pavement. The placement of these inlets should be considered in the overall inlet spacing throughout the curb & gutter limits.
