



**SEQUENCE OF OPERATIONS**

**STAGE IX**

**NOTE:** DAYTIME. Peak hour restrictions as described in the Special Provision entitled "Working Restrictions & Staging Notes" do not apply. See the Special Provision entitled "Working Restrictions & Staging Notes", (No. 17) for working restrictions regarding this stage.

**PURPOSE**

The purpose of this stage is to complete all construction work, excluding milling and overlay of existing pavement, on the north side of Farmington Road and the east and west side of Sterling Avenue. This work includes the reconstruction of Stever and Rhodora Avenues.

**CONSTRUCTION**

The contractor shall be allowed to work anywhere within the area as shown on this sheet with the condition that all working restrictions are followed. The contractor may elect to perform proposed traffic signal work within the NW and NE quadrants of the intersection during this closure.

**TRAFFIC**

**Farmington Road**

Traffic control shall conform to TC&P Standard 701502, except as noted or shown in the plan details and Special Provisions. TC&P Standard 701501 shall be required on the east end where Farmington Road is reduced to two-lane, two-way traffic. Traffic control devices shall only be required within the initial tapers and the north edge of the WB lane as shown in the typical sections and details on this sheet. Because of significant elevation differences, the new widening for the right turn lane on the north side shall remain barricaded off from sta. 33+75 to sta. 35+75.

**Sterling Avenue**

Traffic control shall conform to TC&P Standard 701606, except as noted or shown in the plan details and Special Provisions.
