# SAND DRAINAGE BLANKET

This work shall include constructing a sand drainage blanket as shown in the plans.

Sand shall meet the requirements of Article 1003.04, except gradation FA 6 is not allowed.

The existing ground surface shall be leveled as shown on the plans or as directed by the Engineer prior to placing sand. Ground preparation and sand placement shall be to according to Section 205. Sand shall be compacted to a minimum of 90 percent of the standard laboratory density.

Sand Drainage Blanket will be measured and paid at the contract unit price per cubic yard for SAND DRAINAGE BLANKET.

## ARTICULATED BLOCK REVETMENT MAT

The Articulated Block Revetment Mat shall be an open cell class and be capable of resisting a velocity of 10.25 fps at a flow rate of 1520cfs, except the Articulated Block Revetment Mat shall be a closed cell class downstream of the gabion drop structure for a distance of 10 feet.

Shop drawings shall be submitted according to Article 1042.03(b) to the Design Engineer for approval. Shop drawings will include block size, block weight (mass), mat details, toe in details and anchoring details. Any changes needed to the design or any additional cost incurred shall be the responsibility of the Contractor.

## PERMIT

This project is covered under Regional Permit 38 as contained herein provided all terms and conditions are met.

# REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF REGULATED SUBSTANCES

**Description.** This work shall consist of the removal and disposal of regulated substances according to Section 669 of the Standard Specifications as revised below.

<u>Contract Specific Sites</u>. The excavated soil and groundwater within the areas listed below shall be managed as either "uncontaminated soil", hazardous waste, special waste or non-special waste. For stationing, the lateral distance is measured from centerline and the farthest distance is the offset distance or construction limit, whichever is less.
