## SPECIAL PROVISIONS

The following Special Provisions supplement the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction," adopted January 1, 2007, the latest edition of the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways," and the "Manual of Test Procedures for Materials" in effect on the date of invitation for bids, and the Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions indicated on the Check Sheet included herein which apply to and govern the construction of FAI Routes 57 \& 70, D7 Safety Corridor 2007-1 in Various Counties and in case of conflict with any part or parts of said Specifications, the said Special Provisions shall take precedence and shall govern.

## LOCATION OF PROJECT

This project is located on Interstate Route 70 from the Fayette-Bond County Line to Montrose with an omission from the Kaskaskia River to near Brownstown; on Interstate Route 57 from the Watson Exit to Effingham; near Sigel to near Neoga; and near the Coles County Line to south of Mattoon.

## DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT

The work included in this section consists of milling shoulder rumble strips and pavement markings, and all other work necessary to complete this section.

## WORKING DAYS (BDE)

Effective: January 1, 2002
The Contractor shall complete the work within 60 working days.

## TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN

Traffic Control shall be in accordance with the applicable sections of the Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, the applicable guidelines contained in the Illinois Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, these Special Provisions, and any special details and Highway Standards contained herein and in the plans.

Special attention is called to Articles 107.09, 107.14 and 107.15 of the Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, the following Highway Standards and Special Details relating to traffic control, and these Special Provisions.

Highway Standards:

The existing pavement shall be kept open to traffic at all times except when the actual construction operations require closing a portion of the roadway. At no time shall more than one lane on the mainline and one-half the lane width on the ramps be closed.

Traffic Control shall be in accordance with the traffic control standards and special drawings in the plans except as follows:

TRAFFIC CONTROL (SPECIAL) - This shall apply anytime equipment, vehicles, or workers and their activities will require a continuous or intermittent moving operation where the average speed of movement is greater that 1 mph .

This shall apply to both the shoulder rumble strip operation and the pavement striping located between the I-57/70 interchange south of Effingham and the I-57/70 interchange north of Effingham. This work must be performed between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. only. The work can begin on Sunday evening and must end on Friday morning. This section shall be completed prior to Friday, May 25, 2007. (Memorial Day Weekend)

The contractor shall coordinate traffic control with existing traffic control for the Fourth Street bridge project over l-57/70.

Two changeable message boards shall be required. One shall be located on northbound FAI 57 approximately 5 miles south of the south tri-level and one on eastbound FAI 70 at a location approximately 5 miles west of the south tri-level. Once the work is completed in this direction, the boards shall be relocated. One on southbound FAI 57 at a location approximately 5 miles north of the north tri-level and one on westbound FAI 70 at a location approximately 5 miles north of the north tri-level. These two boards shall be placed in advance of the work to be performed from tri-level to tri-level around Effingham. The messages and final locations will be determined by the Engineer.

This work will be paid for at the contract LUMP SUM price for TRAFFIC CONTROL AND PROTECTION, (SPECIAL).

## LIGHTING FOR NIGHTTIME HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION

Description: This work shall consist of furnishing, installing, operating, maintaining, moving and removing all necessary lighting equipment and materials for the duration of nighttime operations on the contract. Nighttime operations consist of work specifically scheduled during the hours of darkness, which occur 15 minutes before official sunset until 15 minutes after official sunrise. All work shall be done according to the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction" and as further defined herein.
