temporary ramp or as directed by the Engineer. The signs shall remain in place until the temporary ramp is eliminated. The signs will not be paid for separately but shall be included as part of the contract unit bid prices for the traffic control and protection pay items.

4. The Contractor shall erect changeable message signs seven days in advance of implementing Traffic Control and Protection, Standard BLR 21-9. The exact location of changeable message signs shall be confirmed by the Engineer and shall remain in place until the road is closed to traffic.
5. No drop offs at the edge of pavement due to concrete gutter replacement operations will be allowed overnight.
