



- 4. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PLACE CHANGEABLE MESSAGE SIGNS AT THE LOCATIONS SHOWN IN THE DETOUR PLAN TO INFORM MOTORISTS OF THE UPCOMING EB IL RTE. 132 ROAD CLOSURE A MINIMUM OF FOURTEEN (14) DAYS IN ADVANCE OF THE CLOSURE. THE IMPROVEMENTS WILL BE CONSTRUCTED AS PER PLANS AND AS PER IDOT HIGHWAY STANDARDS 701006, 701011, 701301, 701311, 701501, 701502, 701701. 701801, 701901 AND DISTRICT ONE STANDARDS TC-10, TC-11, TC-13, TC-16, TC-21, TC-22, TC-26.

PRE-STAGE I:

TRAFFIC: USE DAILY LANE CLOSURES DURING ALLOWABLE HOURS ONLY AS SPECIFIED IN THE SPECIAL PROVISION "KEEPING ARTERIAL ROADWAYS OPEN TO TRAFFIC".




