## TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN

Traffic Control shall be in accordance with the applicable sections of the Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, the applicable guidelines contained in the Illinois Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, these Special Provisions, and any special details and Highway Standards contained herein and in the plans.

Special attention is called to Articles 107.09, 107.14 and 107.15 of the Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction on the following:

Highway Standards Traffic Control Standard 701801, 701901, 701001, 701006, 701011, 701501.

Traffic Control conforming to Standard 701801 and 701901, 701001, 701006, 701011 will be paid for at the Contract Unit Price per LUMP SUM, for TRAFFIC CONTROL AND PROTECTION, (SPECIAL).

Traffic Control conforming to Standard 701501 will be paid for at the contract LUMP SUM price for TRAFFIC CONTROL AND PROTECTION, STANDARD 701501.

#### **OVERHAUL**

No payment for Overhaul will be allowed for earth hauled from any source.

#### SALVAGE MATERIALS

Existing materials on the project that are to be removed which are of salvageable value as determined by the engineer shall remain the property of the Village of Dieterich. These items shall be carefully removed by the Contractor and stored as designated by the Village of Dieterich for salvage to the Village of Dieterich. The cost of such removal and storage shall be included in to the project and no additional compensation will be allowed. All existing material not of salvageable value as determined by the engineer, shall be disposed of offsite.

# LIGHT POLE STREET AND SIDEWALK SPECIAL

The light poles shall be designed in accordance with Article 1069.01 and shall be nontapered straight 5" diameter round fluted aluminum Sternberg 6220 FP5/BCC, with a mast height as shown in the plans and straight to within 1/8 inch in every 10 feet of length.

All poles shall include a reinforced hand hole with cover not less than 3" x 8" and the hand holes shall be located on the backside of the pole away from the street. The hand hole cover shall be attached by stainless steel allen head screws. All poles shall be prewired to conform to the National Electric Code.

Each pole shall be provided with a ground lug or stud accessible through the hand hole.

Poles shall be furnished with bolt covers.

Each pole shall be equipped with a 3 Sternberg CAS roadway arm, hang straight arm coupling, Sternberg 1527R/FG/CAS 4 250 watt High Pressure Sodium fixture, clear flat tempered lens, Roof Optics, Type 3 with a 27" diameter shade.

Each pole shall also be equipped with a Sternberg A850/5P/PT, 100 watt High Pressure Sodium Louver Optics Fixture, Type 3.

The pole base shall be Sternberg Oxford 6200 style base and shall include four anchor bolts and one ground lug.

East pole shall be equipped with a flag pole holder, banner brackets, and convenience outlet. These items shall be included in the light pole. The unit price, Each, for LIGHT POLE STREET AND SIDEWALK SPECIAL, shall include all labor and material, to install the light pole as shown in the plans and stated in the above specifications along with the additional equipment.

# BALLASTS

Ballasts for the lighting fixtures shall be Advance, high pressure sodium ballasts, Catalog No. 71A8071 for 100 watt luminaries and Catalog No. 71A8271 for 250 watt luminaries. The cost for furnishing and installing ballasts shall be included in the unit price EACH for the LIGHT POLE STREET AND SIDEWALK, SPECIAL.
