The height and thickness of the Locking Edge Rails shown are minimum dimensions. The actual configuration of the Locking Edge Rails and matching strip seal may vary from manufacturer to manufacturer. Flanged edge rails will not be allowed.

The inside of the Locking Edge Rail groove shall be free of weld residue.


Locking Edge Rails may be spliced at slope discontinuities and stage construction joints.

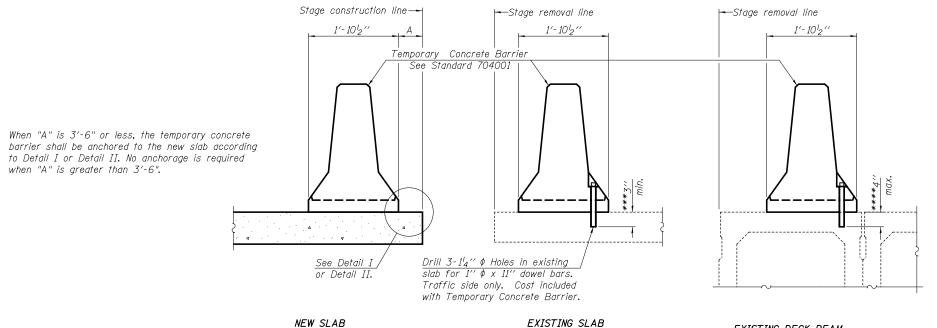
MICROSILICA REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT SEQUENCE (BRIDGE DECK)

Areas 2, 4, & 6 over the pier shall be done before areas 1, 3, 5 & 7 in order to maintain the structural integrity of the negative moment reinforcement bars. At least 72 hours shall have elapses from the end of the previous pour and the concrete shall have attained a minimum modulus of rupture of 650 psi or a minimum compressive strength of 3500 psi. Care shall be taken not to debond the top mat of negative moment reinforcement during concrete removal. Any deviations from this sequence must be approved by the Engineer prior to removal operations.

Detail I - With Bar Splicer or Couplers:

Connect one (1) 1" \times 7" ' \times "W" steel P to the top layer of couplers with $2^{-5}8$ " ϕ bolts screwed to coupler at approximate Q of each barrier panel.

Detail II - With Extended Reinforcement Bars:

Connect one (1) 1" x 7" x "W" steel 1 to the concrete slab or concrete wearing surface with 2-58" \$\phi\$ Expansion Anchors or cast in place inserts spaced between the top layer of reinforcement at approximate \$\mathbb{C}\$ of each barrier panel.


Cost of anchorage is included with Temporary Concrete Barrier.


The I'' x 7'' x 'W'' plate shall not be removed until stage II construction forms and all reinforcement bars are in place and the concrete is ready to be placed.

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





BAR SPLICER ASSEMBLY FOR #5 BAR ON INTEGRAL OR SEMI-INTEGRAL ABUTMENTS




