1. Skip-Dash markings will be centered between both ends of city blocks and shall be placed in alignment transversly across the pavement.

CCC&G (Typical - No edge stripe

- 2. The following shall apply to arrows located in one-way left turn lanes:
- A. A minimum of two (2) arrows is required.
  - The maximum spacing between arrows is 80' (24 m).
- Arrows shall be evenly spaced if three (3) or more are required.
- 3. The following shall apply to arrow pairs located in two-way left turn lanes:
  - A. A minimum of two (2) arrow pairs is required. The maximum spacing between arrow pairs is 200' (61 m).
- Arrow pairs shall be evenly spaced if three (3) or more are required.
- D. The spacing between Bi Directional Left Turn Arrows is 33' (10 m).
