




LOCATION MAP NOT TO SCALE






LIGHT POLE HANDHOLE WIRING DIAGRAM






PARAPET JOINT DETAILS




INSIDE ELEVATION OF PARAPET AND CURB

(West Approach)


INSIDE ELEVATION OF PARAPET AND CURB

ELEVATION - PROPOSED EAST ABUTMENT








PIER 1 ELEVATION (Looking East)




