STAGE 2 (AFTER PAVEMENT MILLING)

- A) REMOVE THE HMA SURFACE MIX AND CRUSHED STONE.
- B) INSTALL THE FRAME AND LID; ADJUST THE FRAME TO ITS FINAL SURFACE ELEVATION.
- C) THE SURROUNDING SPACE SHALL BE FILLED WITH CLASS SI CONCRETE, OR HWA SURRACE COURSE OR HMA BINDER COURSE TO THE ELEVATION OF THE SURFACE OF THE EXISTING BASE COURSE OR THE BINDER COURSE.




TYPICAL CROSSWALK MARKING



"FAR OUT" DETECTION REFERS TO LOCKING, PRESENCE TYPE DETECTION LOCATED IN THRU LANES, RIGHT TURN LANES, AND RIGHT TURN LANE TAPER AREAS (IF APPLICABLE), USUALLY 250' (75 m) IN ADVANCE OF STOP BARS. "UPTIGHT" DETECTION REFERS TO NON-LOCKING PRESENCE TYPE DETECTION LOCATED IN ALL LANES AND 10'-15' (3.0 m-4.5 m) BEHIND THE CROSSING STREET'S EDGE OF PAVEMENT EXTENDED.
