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TEMPORARY WOOD POLE, 60 FT, CLASS 4, 8 FT MAST ARM

Description:

This item will consist of furnishing, installing and removing a temporary wood pole with 8 foot mast arm, used for the temporary surveillance system of the size and description as shown on the plans, and shall include all hardware and accessories required for the intended temporary use of the pole

Material:

The wood pole must be 60 feet in length and meet the requirements of Article 1069.04 of the Standard Specifications. The mast arm assembly's must be 8 feet in length, together with mounting hardware and meet the requirements of Article 1069.02 (a).

Provide a ground rod which shall be not less than 5/8 inch in diameter and not less than 10 feet in length and copper ground wire as follows:

Item Article/Section
(a) Ground Rod 1087.01(b)
(b) Copper Ground Wire 1087.01(a)

Installation:

The wood pole must be installed as described in Article 830.03(c) of the Standard Specifications and/or as directed by the engineer. The Contractor shall provide all hardware to install the pole as specified herein and indicated on the plans.

Removal:

The wood pole shall remain the property of the Contractor and shall be removed when directed by the Engineer. The work shall be performed in accordance with Article 841.02 of the Standard Specifications with the exception that no luminaires must be salvaged.

Method of Measurement:

This work will be measured for payment in units per each for LIGHT POLE, WOOD, 60 FT, CLASS 4, 8 FT MAST ARM.

Basis of Payment:

This work will be paid for at the contract unit price per each for LIGHT POLE, WOOD, 60 FT, CLASS 4, 8 FT MAST ARM, which shall be payment in full for furnishing, installing and removing the equipment as shown on the plans.

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COMBINATION CONCRETE CURB AND GUTTER

<u>Description</u>. This work shall consist of constructing combination concrete curb and gutter in accordance with Section 606 of the Standard Specifications, the Highway Standards and details included in the contract plans and the following:

Tie bars shall be epoxy coated reinforcement bars in accordance with Article 1006.10 of the Standard Specifications.

<u>Method of Measurement</u>. This work shall be measured for payment in accordance with Article 606.14.

Basis of Payment. This work shall be paid for in accordance with Article 606.15 and the following:

Tie bars shall be included in the contract unit cost for COMBINATION CONCRETE CURB AND GUTTER, of the type specified.

PORTLAND CEMENT CONCRETE PAVEMENT (JOINTED)

<u>Description</u>. This work shall consist of constructing jointed portland cement concrete pavement in accordance with Section 420 of the Standard Specifications, the Highway Standards and details included in the contract plans and the following:

Tie bars shall be epoxy coated reinforcement bars in accordance with Article 1006.10 of the Standard Specifications.

<u>Method of Measurement</u>. This work shall be measured for payment in accordance with Article 420.19.

Basis of Payment. This work shall be paid for in accordance with Article 420.20 and the following:

Tie bars shall be included in the contract unit cost for PORTLAND CEMENT CONCRETE PAVEMENT (JOINTED), of the thickness specified.
