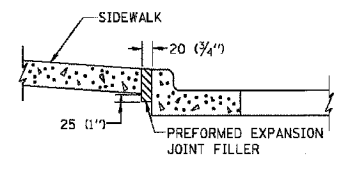
- NOTES:
- EXPANSION JOINTS SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED AS SHOWN ON THE DETAILS FOR P.C.C. SIDEWALK.
 - THE CURB BETWEEN ADJACENT DRIVEWAYS SHALL BE FULL HEIGHT FOR A DISTANCE OF AT LEAST FOUR 1.2 METERS (4 FEET).
 - P.C. CONCRETE DRIVEWAYS SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED AT LOCATIONS SHOWN ON THE PLANS OR AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.
 - 20 (3/4) PREFORMED EXPANSION JOINTS WILL NOT BE PAID FOR SEPARATELY BUT SHALL BE CONSIDERED INCIDENTAL TO P.C.C. DRIVEWAY PAVEMENT 200 (8"). COMBINATION CONC. CURB AND GUTTER SHALL BE MEASURED STRAIGHT ACROSS THE DRIVEWAY. NO ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION WILL BE ALLOWED FOR THE TRANSITION CURB AND GUTTER.



P.C.C. DRIVEWAY PAVEMENT DETAIL

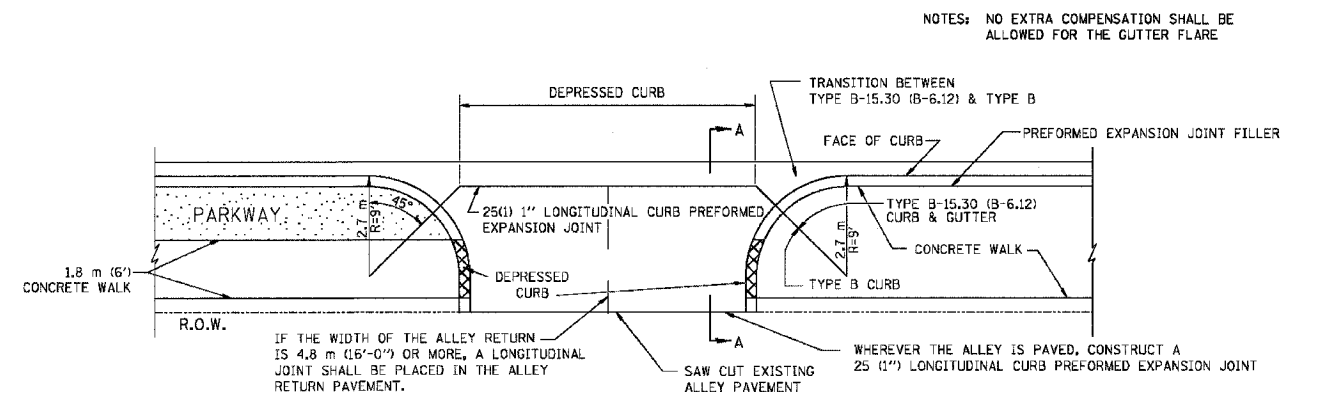


- NOTES:
- ONE-HALF INCH THICK EXPANSION JOINTS SHALL BE PLACED BETWEEN THE SIDEWALK AND ALL STRUCTURES SUCH AS LIGHT STANDARDS, TRAFFIC LIGHT STANDARDS, MANHOLES, WHICH EXTEND THROUGH THE SIDEWALK.
 - 20 (3/4) THICK EXPANSION JOINTS SHALL BE PLACED AT INTERVALS OF NOT MORE THAN 30 METERS (100 FEET) IN THE SIDEWALK. WHERE THE SIDEWALK IS CONSTRUCTED ADJACENT TO PAVEMENT OR CURB HAVING EXPANSION JOINTS, THE EXPANSION JOINTS IN THE SIDEWALK SHALL BE PLACED OPPOSITE THE EXISTING EXPANSION JOINTS AS NEARLY AS PRACTICABLE. EXPANSION JOINTS SHALL ALSO BE PLACED WHERE THE SIDEWALK ABUTS EXISTING SIDEWALKS, BETWEEN DRIVEWAY PAVEMENT AND SIDEWALK, AND BETWEEN SIDEWALK AND CURBS WHERE THE SIDEWALK ABUTS A CURB.

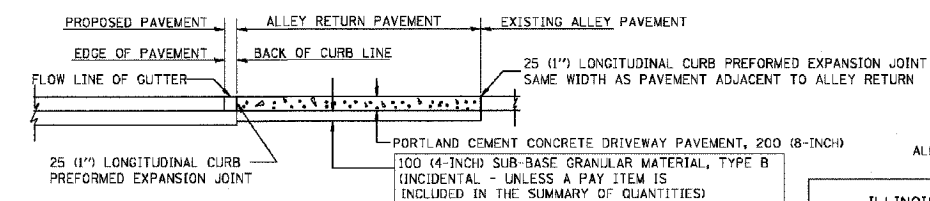


SLOPE FOR SIDEWALK
