- A STRIPING KEY IS AVAILABLE ELSEWHERE AND SHALL BE SHOWN WHERE THE QUANTITIES ARE LISTED.
- 5. FINAL PAVEMENT MARKINGS SHALL BE IN PLACE PRIOR TO PLACING ANY RAISED REFLECTIVE PAVEMENT MARKERS.
- 6. THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA SHALL BE USED FOR SELECTING
 THE DIAGONAL PAVEMENT MARKING SPACING,
 <30 MPH USE 15' (<50 km/h USE 4.5 m)
 30-45 MPH USE 20' (50-75 km/h USE 6.0 m)
 >45 MPH USE 30' (>75 km/h USE 9.0 m)
