# PLANTING BED PREPARATION (SPECIAL)

<u>DESCRIPTION</u>: This work shall consist of the in-field layout of proposed planting beds, removal of existing plant materials within proposed bed areas, removal of all debris from proposed bed areas, excavation and removal of existing soils within proposed bed areas, and the supply and placement of an engineered soil matrix within proposed bed areas

Prior to beginning work, Contractor shall submit a proposed work schedule to the Engineer outlining when the tasks and materials required as part of this Special Provision will be completed.

**EXPERIENCE**: All work shall be performed by a Contractor with at least five (5) years of documented experience in the preparation of landscape beds for the purposes of commercial landscaping, they shall be able to demonstrate their knowledge in the field.

## **MATERIALS**:

### **ENGINEERED SOIL**

Uniform in composition, dry, and fully mixed by supplier prior to delivery to the site.

Engineered soil mixture shall be CMS AG or equal blended mix with the following material ratios:

Product Description	Percentage of Mix By Dry Weight
Topsoil (Standard Specification 1081.05a)	60%
FM20 Sand (Standard Specification 1003.01c)	20%
Southern Pine Bark Fines Screened to 3/8" or smaller	20%

### HERBICIDE
