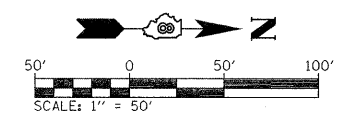


- GENERAL NOTES:**
- 1) DRUMS OR BARRICADES SHALL BE LOCATED ON THE EXISTING EDGE OF PAVEMENT DURING WORKING HOURS AND SHALL BE LOCATED OFF OF THE EXISTING EDGE OF PAVEMENT DURING NON-WORKING HOURS. EXTENDED LEG BARRICADES WITH LIGHTS ARE REQUIRED WHERE THE EDGE DROP OFF IS 3" OR GREATER. LIGHTS SHALL BE STEADY BURNING WHERE THE LENGTH OF THE WORKZONE IS GREATER THAN 100'.
 - 2) CONTRACTOR SHALL STAGE TRAFFIC SUCH THAT ACCESS TO PRIVATE PROPERTY IS MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES.
