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SEEDING

All areas disturbed during construction, including, but not limited to grading and shaping ditches shall be seeded with Class 2 seeding as specified in Section 250 of the Standard Specifications.

All disturbed areas shall be covered in Mulch in accordance with Section 250 of the Standard Specifications. The contractor shall use Method 2. Seeding will not be paid for separately but shall be included in the cost of the construction operation for which it is required. Seeding shall include fertilizer nutrients and mulch at the rates specified in Sections 250 and 251 of the Standard Specifications.

HOT-MIX ASPHALT SHOULDER REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT (SPECIAL)

<u>Description</u>: This pay item is intended to be used for the removal and replacement of the existing HMA Shoulder in areas that have deteriorated primarily due to traffic moving onto the shoulder from the adjacent lane closure operations. It will also be used on deteriorated shoulders in areas that are anticipated to have traffic temporarily moved onto the shoulder in advance of pavement patching, milling, and paving operations.

This work shall consist of removal and disposal of existing Hot-Mix Asphalt Shoulders at locations directed by the Engineer. Removal and disposal shall be in accordance with the applicable portion of Section 440 of the Standard Specifications.

This work shall also consist of the replacement of the HMA Shoulders to a thickness of eight (8) inches. The replacement of the HMA Shoulders shall be in accordance with the applicable portion of Section 482 of the Standard Specifications.

<u>Method of Measurement</u>: Removal and Replacement of hot-mix asphalt shoulder will be measured for payment in place and the area computed in square yards.

<u>Basis of Payment</u>: This work will be paid for at the contract unit price per square yard for HOT-MIX ASPHALT SHOULDER REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT (SPECIAL).
