





### GENERAL NOTES


- 1. No field welding is permitted except as specified in the contract documents.
- 2. Reinforced bars designated (E) shall be epoxy coated.
- 3. Prior to pouring the new concrete deck, all heavy or loose rust, loose mill scale, and other loose or potentially detrimental foreign material shall be removed from the surfaces in contact with concrete. Tightly adhered paint may remain unless otherwise noted. Removal shall be accomplished by methods that will not damage the steel and the cost will be included in the pay item covering removal of the existing concrete.

As directed by the Engineer, existing construction accessories welded to the top flange of beams and girders shall be removed. The weld areas shall be ground flush and inspected for cracks using magnetic particle testing (MT) or dye penetrant testing (PT) by qulaified personnel approved by the Engineer. Any cracks that can not be removed by grinding ¼ in. deep shall be identified and reported to the Bureau of Bridges and Structures for further disposition. The cost of removing welded accessories, grinding and inspecting weld areas and grinding cracks will be paid for according to Article 109.04 of the Standard Specifications.

- 4. Plan dimensions and details relative to existing plans are subject to nominal construction variations. The Contractor shall field verify existing dimensions and details affecting new construction and make necessary approved adjustments prior to construction or ordering of materials. Such variations shall not be cause for additional compensation for a change in scope of the work, however, the Contractor will be paid for the quantity actually furnished at the unit price bid for the work.
- 5. The existing structural steel coating contains lead. The Contractor shall take appropriate precautions to deal with the presence of lead on this project.
- 6. Existing structural steel beams shall be painted for a distance of 4'-0" at each end and for entire length on exterior face of fascia beams.





All bearing plates shall be AASHTO M270 Grade 50. Anchor bolts shall be ASTM F1554 all-thread (or an Engineer-approved alternate material) of the grade(s) and diameter(s) specified. The corresponding specified grade of AASHTO M314 anchor bolts may be used in lieu of ASTM F1554.


Side retainers and other steel members required for the elastomeric bearing assembly shall be included in the cost of Elastomeric Bearing Assembly, Type I.

Anchor bolts and side retainers at all supports shall be installed as each member is erected unless an equivalent temporary means of lateral restraint is used. Field drill holes into existing beamseat and epoxy grout

threaded anchor bolts to avoid existing reinforcement bars. Contractor shall field drill and set 5%" dia. threaded rods into existing concrete beamseat to avoid existing reinforcement

bars according to Article 509.06 of the Standard Specifications. Two 1/8 in. adjusting shims shall be provided for each bearing in addition to all other plates or shims and placed as







# JACK AND REMOVE EXISTING BEARING PROCEDURE

- 1. The contractor shall submit for approval by the engineer, plans for jacking existing beams and installing new bearings prior to commencing any related work. The maximum dead load reaction per beam (weight of steel only) is 4.7k at the abutments.
- 2. Prior to ordering any material, the contractor shall verify shim plate thickness required
- 3. Jack and Remove Existing bearings shall be done after the existing deck is removed and prior to placeing the new deck.
- 4. Jacking shall be limited to a maximum of 1/4" lift to remove existing bearing.
- The new bearings and shim plates shall be in place and the jacks shall be lowered before the new concrete deck is poured.




