

## **US Army Corps of Engineers 408 Permit Clarifications of the specific details of the permit required to be completed by the Contractor**

- a. Emergency Action Plan shall be in accordance with OSHA standards and at a minimum, the plan must include but is not limited to the following elements:

### **29 CFR 1910.38(c) Minimum elements of an emergency action plan.**

An emergency action plan must include at a minimum:

1910.38(c)(1) Procedures for reporting a fire or other emergency;

1910.38(c)(2) Procedures for emergency evacuation, including type of evacuation and exit route assignments;

1910.38(c)(3) Procedures to be followed by employees who remain to operate critical plant operations before they evacuate;

1910.38(c)(4) Procedures to account for all employees after evacuation;

1910.38(c)(5) Procedures to be followed by employees performing rescue or medical duties; and

1910.38(c)(6) The name or job title of every employee who may be contacted by employees who need more information about the plan or an explanation of their duties under the plan.

- c. Contractor is responsible for any damages to Federal property outside the construction limits of the project and shall be restored to existing condition. The contractor is responsible for the construction in accordance with the design plans.

- f. St. Louis District shall be included within the final walk thru of the project.
- g. Final Audit and walk-thru shall be supplied to the St. Louis District.
- h. St. Louis District shall be notified 72 hours prior to construction and its contact shall be kept updated of the construction schedule.
