Justification for use of project Labor Agreement on Contract 70840 Vermilion County:

The use of a project Labor Agreement on this project is consistent with all State and Local statutory regulatory requirements.

Project Description: This project is for the milling, resurfacing, ADA improvements and culvert replacement on IL 1 from the Iroquois County Line to 0.2 miles north of the Rossville south corporate limits in Vermilion County. Other improvements associated with the project include guardrail removal and replacement, earthwork, seeding, mulch and pavement markings.

- **Item 3:** Estimated project cost is \$5,780,00. The use of a PLA will assure the project will be completed efficiently.
- **Item 4:** The working days are 100. The completion of this contract would extend into 2024 based on the number of working days available for 2023 with a contract on the April 2023 letting.
- **Item 6:** Carpenters Local 243's contract expires 4/30/2023. Laborers Local 703's contract expires 4/30/2023.
- **Item 8:** Any disruption to the contractor's schedule due to labor issues may result in an increase in duration of the project. This, in turn, would increase the length of time the traffic control on IL 1 will be in place. The district desires to minimize the length of time traffic control is on IL 1 to reduce the potential for crashes and improve safety.
