Justification for use of project Labor Agreement on Contract 70E17 McLean County:

The use of a project Labor Agreement on this project is consistent with all State and Local statutory regulatory requirements.

Project Description: This project is for the milling, resurfacing, and guardrail improvements on I-55 from the Logan County Line to 1.8 mile south of Shirley. Other improvements associated with the project include patching and pavement markings.

- **Item 3:** Estimated project cost is \$29,727,000. The use of a PLA will assure the project will be completed efficiently.
- **Item 4:** The working days are 110. The completion of this contract would extend into 2024 based on the number of working days available for 2023 with a contract on the April 2023 letting.
