<u>Basis of Payment</u>. Providing Railroad Protective Liability and Property Damage Liability Insurance will be paid for at the contract unit price per Lump Sum for RAILROAD PROTECTIVE LIABILITY INSURANCE.

## PREPARATION AND RESTORATION OF SIDEWALK WORK AREAS

Furnished excavation and earth excavation necessary to complete sidewalk work will not be paid for separately, but it shall be included in the cost of the sidewalk pay items.

At any locations where the existing sidewalk elevations require modification to meet ADA compliance, the work shall include leveling and shaping of the existing ground/subbase to provide for the required ADA compliant slopes as shown in the plan details, including any required furnished excavation, earth excavation under the proposed sidewalk necessary to complete the work and restore any disturbed areas.

The Contractor shall restore the sidewalk work area as specified in Article 104.06 of the Standard Specifications. All damage to mowed lawns shall be replaced with an approved sod, and all damage to unmowed fields shall be seeded. This work will not be paid for separately, but shall be included in the cost of the associated sidewalk pay items. Restoration items include, but are not limited to, furnished excavation, earth excavation, seeding, sodding, fertilizer nutrients, and erosion control blanket.

Earth Excavation required for the removal of non-special waste disposal will be measured and paid separately.

The 4-Inch Aggregate Base Course, Type B (CA 6 material) required for the sidewalks will be measured and paid separately.
