

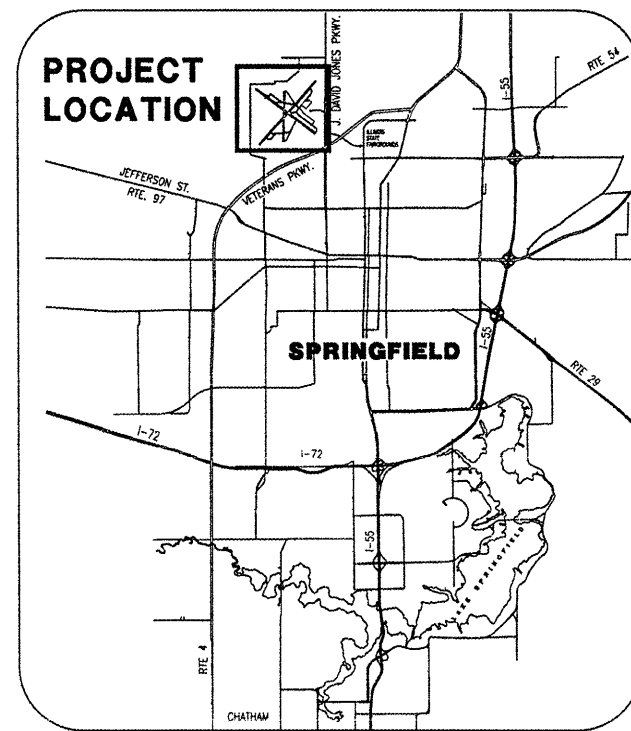

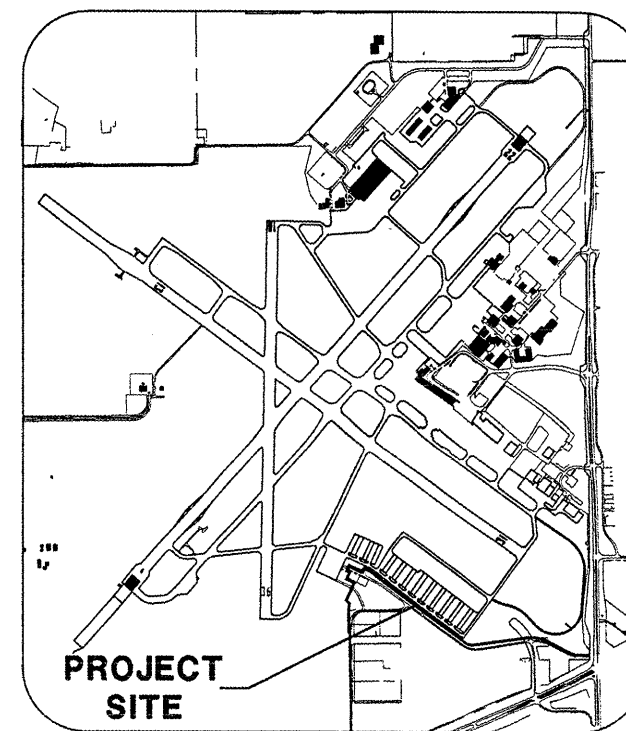

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY UTILITY COMPANIES OF HIS OPERATIONAL PLANS, OBTAIN FROM RESPECTIVE UTILITY COMPANIES DETAILED INFORMATION AND ASSISTANCE RELATIVE TO THE LOCATION OF THEIR FACILITIES AND THE WORKING SCHEDULE OF THE COMPANIES FOR REMOVAL OR ADJUSTMENT WHERE REQUIRED. IN THE EVENT AN UNEXPECTED UTILITY INTERFERENCE IS ENCOUNTERED DURING CONSTRUCTION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL IMMEDIATELY NOTIFY THE UTILITY COMPANY OF JURISDICTION AND THE ONE-CALL NOTICE SYSTEM. THE ENGINEER SHALL ALSO BE IMMEDIATELY NOTIFIED. ANY SUCH UTILITY OR SERVICES SHALL BE RESTORED TO SERVICE AT ONCE AND PAID FOR BY THE CONTRACTOR AT NO ADDITIONAL COST TO THE CONTRACT.
