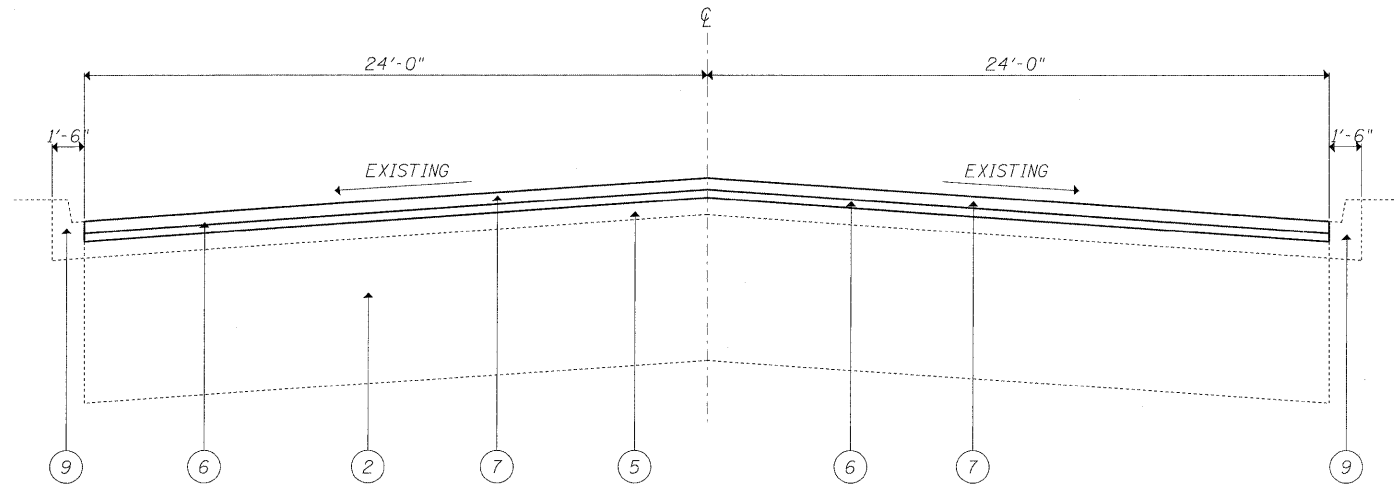


EXISTING TYPICAL SECTION

CLASS D PATCHES (HMA BINDER IL 19 mm)	PG 64-22*	4% @ 70 GYR
HMA REPLACEMENT OVER PATCHES (HMA BINDER IL 19 mm)	PG 64-22*	4% @ 70 GYR

- 1: THE UNIT WEIGHT USED TO CALCULATE ALL HMA SURFACE COURSE MIXTURES IS 112 LBS/SQYD/IN. *WHEN RAP EXCEEDS 20%. THE NEW ASPHALT BINDER IN THE MIX SHALL BE PG 58-22
 - 2: THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PATCH FIRST BEFORE MILLING
 - 3: SHOULDER WIDENING GREATER THAN 4' AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF IMPROVEMENT
