 LESS THAN 4.0%. WHEN SE EXCEEDS 4.0%, SLOPE SHLD.
 NOT TO EXCEED ALGEBRAIC DIFFERENCE OF 8.0% BETWEEN
 PAVEMENT AND SHOULDER.
