# SPECIAL PROVISIONS

The following Special Provisions supplement the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction," adopted January 1, 2007, the latest edition of the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways," and the "Manual of Test Procedures for Materials" in effect on the date of invitation for bids, and the Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions indicated on the Check Sheet included herein which apply to and govern the construction of Route: FAP 607 (US 52 / Troy Road), Project **F-0607 (076)**, Section 130 RS-3, Will County, Contract 62787 and in case of conflict with any part or parts of said Specifications, the said Special Provisions shall take precedence and shall govern.

## LOCATION OF PROJECT

This project begins on US 52 / Troy Road (FAP 607) approximately 69 feet West of Kendall County line and extends in a easterly direction through the Village of Shorewood in Will County to 340 feet east of the center line of River Road for a distance of 10,731 linear feet (2.03miles).

### DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT

This is a resurfacing project and the work to be performed under this contract consist of pavement patching, hot-mix asphalt surface removal, resurfacing with 1-½" HMA surface course, Mixture D, <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" and polymerized leveling binder (Machine Method), thermoplastic pavement markings and all incidental and collateral work necessary to complete the improvement as shown on the plans and as described herein.

# MAINTENANCE OF ROADWAYS

Effective: September 30, 1985 Revised: November 1, 1996

Beginning on the date that work begins on this project, the Contractor shall assume responsibility for normal maintenance of all existing roadways within the limits of the improvement. This normal maintenance shall include all repair work deemed necessary by the Engineer, but shall not include snow removal operations. Traffic control and protection for maintenance of roadways will be provided by the Contractor as required by the Engineer.

If items of work have not been provided in the contract, or otherwise specified for payment, such items, including the accompanying traffic control and protection required by the Engineer, will be paid for in accordance with Article 109.04 of the Standard Specifications.
