TWO WEEK NOTIFICATION PRIOR TO STARTING WORK

Effective December 2005

Revise the first sentence of Article 107.09 Public Convenience and Safety to the following "The Contractor shall notify the Engineer at least 14 days in advance of starting any construction work.

This additional notification is required so that the public can be notified of the pending construction.

LATE START OF MULTIPLE CONTRACTS

The Department may allow a contractor to delay the start of work if they are awarded multiple contracts on a single letting provided the apparent low bidder submits a written request for waiver within 10 days after bid opening to the District Project Implementation Engineer.

The request shall include specific reasons for the waiver in a starting date coordination plan and a suggested preliminary progress schedule for each project. The District will schedule a meeting with the Contractor within 5 working days after receipt of the request for waiver. Procedures and schedules to the prosecution of each contract will be discussed and anticipated starting dates for each project will be established. Consideration of waivers will not affect award decisions or the procedures followed to execute awarded contracts.

The intent of this is to allow the Contractor reasonable flexibility to complete each of the affected contracts within the number of working days specified in each contract in the context of the total work to be completed. No start date shall be delayed, in the starting date coordination plan, in a manner that leaves insufficient working days to complete all work, except off-pavement and/or cleanup work, by **June 15, 2015**. Working days shall be charged in accordance with Article 108.04 or the Standard Specifications when the Contractor begins actual construction work.

By submission of a waiver plan, the Contractor understands and agrees that the granting of waivers in any contract starting date shall not be reason for an extension of time to complete and that the decision to approve a waiver for any or all contracts shall reside with the Department, which decision shall be final.

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PAINT CURB

Description of Work: This work shall consist of applying pavement marking material to the top and face of existing curb.

Materials: Materials shall be according to Article 780.02(a) of the standard specifications.

Construction Requirements: The curb surface shall be cleaned by a method approved by the Engineer. The prepared curb surface shall be clean, dry and free of grease, latents and debris. If the curb surface has been previously painted, the prepared surface shall also be free of loose and/or chipped paint. The cleaned surface shall be inspected and approved by the Engineer before any paint is applied.

Paint material shall be applied according to Article 780.06 of the Standard Specifications.

Method of Measurement: This work will be measured in place in the field for payment in feet for PAINT CURB.

Basis of Payment: The completed work will be paid for at the contract unit price per foot for PAINT CURB.

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
