Plan dimenstions and details relative to existing plans are subject to nominal construction variations. The Contractor shall field verify existing dimensions and details affecting new construction andm ace necessary onpproved aonjustments
prior to construction or ordering of moterials. Such variations shall not be couse for additional compensotion for o change in scope of the work, however, the Conntractor will be paid for the quantity octually furnished of the unit price
bid for the work.

Reinforcement Bars designated (E) shall be epoxy cooted.
Existing reinforcement bars extending into the removal area shall be cleaned, straightened and incorporated into the Removal perations shall be replaced usino an approved bar spicer on
an ambient temperature other than $50^{\circ}$ F.
Areas of deck repairs shown are estimated. The Engineer shall show actual locations of deck repairs on as-built plans Removal and reinstallation of the nameplote and handrail sections and support posts at both abutments will be necessory s. The existing handrail sections and support provided and installed for the reinstollation of the handrail and supports. This work and all moterials shall be
included in the contract unit price for CONCRETE SUPERSTRUCTURE.
Prior to pouring the new conorete deck, all heary and loose rust, loose mill scale, and other loose or potentially detrimental foreign material shall be removed from the surfoces in contoct with concrete. Tightly odhered paint may
remain unless otherwise noted. Removol sholl be occomplished by methods that will not damage the steel, and the cost remain unless otherwise noted. Removal shall be accomplished by methods
will be included in the pay item covering removal of the existing concrete.

The removal and reinstallation of the first section of guardrail ot each abutment to allow construction of the north expansion joint shall be included in the controct unit price for CONCRETE SUPERSTRUCTURE.
All structural steel shall conform to AASHTO Classification M-270 Gr. 36 unless otherwise noted.
