





- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONDUCT OPERATIONS AS TO MAINTAIN AT ALL TIMES FLOW THROUGH EXIS SEWER SYSTEMS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ALSO PROVIDE AND MAINTAIN AN EFFICIENT PUMPING PLA TEMPORARY OUTLET AND BE PREPARED AT ALL TIMES TO DISPOSE OF THE WATER COLLECTED IN A SA DAMAGE OF ANY KIND TO ADJACENT PROPERTIES. - WHEN MILLED PAVEMENT IS OPEN TO TRAFFIC THE MAXIMUM GRADE DIFFERENTIAL BETWEEN PASSES OF THE MILLING MACHINE 13. SHALL NOT EXCEED 1¹/₂ INCHES (40 MM) WHERE THE SPEED LIMIT IS 45 MPH (80 KM/H) OR LESS AND 1 INCH (25 MM) WHERE THE SPEED LIMIT IS GREATER THAN 45 MPH (80 KM/H). WITH WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM THE ENGINEER, A MAXIMUM GRADE DIFFERENTIAL OF 3 INCHES (75 MM) MAY BE ALLOWED IF THE EDGE OF THE MILLING IS SLOPED A MINIMUM 1:3 (V:H).
- 14. THE CONTRACTOR WILL BE REQUIRED TO SCHEDULE THEIR OPERATIONS SO THAT NO SECTIONS OF PAVEMENT ALONG THE CENTERLINE WILL HAVE A COLD JOINT OVERNIGHT.
- 15. LOCATIONS OF CLASS B PATCHES ON PLANS ARE APPROXIMATE. EXACT LOCATIONS WILL BE DETERMINED IN THE FIELD BY ENGINEER. CLASS B PATCHES LOCATED WITHIN THE THROUGH LANES SHALL BE MADE ACCESSIBLE TO TRAFFIC AT THE END OF EACH WORK DAY.
- 16. PAVEMENT PATCHING SHALL BE STAGED TO MAINTAIN TWO-WAY TRAFFIC AT ALL TIMES.
- 17. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN ACCESS FOR EMERGENCY VEHICLES AND GARBAGE TRUCKS AT ALL TIMES. IF THE GARBAGE TRUCKS ARE NOT ABLE TO HAVE ACCESS TO ALL OF THE PROPERTIES WITHIN THE PROJECT LIMITS, THEN THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PLACE ANY GARBAGE THAT IS AFFECTED IN A LOCATION WHERE THE GARBAGE TRUCKS CAN PICK IT UP. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL RETURN THE GARBAGE CANS TO THE PARKWAY OF THE RESPECTIVE PROPERTY BY THE END OF THE DAY.
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL TAKE PRECAUTIONS SO AS NOT TO DAMAGE EXISTING SIDEWALKS, DRIVEWAYS, AND PAVEMENTS OUTSIDE THE LIMITS OF RESTORATION. THE GENERAL LIMITS OF RESTORATION ARE SHOWN ON THE PLANS. - 2. THE VILLAGE OF BROOKFIELD ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT AND PUBLIC MUST BE NOTIFIED AT LEAST 24 HOURS PRIOR TO THE START OF CONSTRUCTION AND PRIOR TO EACH PHASE OF WORK. CONTRACTOR SHALL DETERMINE ITEMS REQUIRING INSPECTION PRIOR TO START OF CONSTRUCTION OR EACH WORK PHASE.
- b. GENERAL NOTES
- 1. ELEVATION DATUM IS C.C.D.

ALL SANITARY SEWER CONSTRUCTION (AND STORM SEWER CONSTRUCTION IN COMBINED SEWER AREAS), REQUIRES STONE BEDDING WITH STONE '%" TO 1" IN SIZE, WITH MINIMUM BEDDING THICKNESS EQUAL TO 1/4 THE OUTSIDE DIAMETER OF THE SEWER PIPE, BUT NOT LESS THAN FOUR (4) INCHES NOR MORE THAN EIGHT (8) INCHES: MATERIAL SHALL BE CA-7, CA-11 OR CA-13 AND SHALL BE EXTENDED AT LEAST 12" ABOVE THE TOP OF THE PIPE WHEN USING PVC.

- b) REMOVE AN ENTIRE SECTION OF PIPE (BREAKING ONLY THE TOP OF ONE BELL) AND REPLACE WITH A WYE OR TEE BRANCH SECTION.
- c) WITH PIPE CUTTER, NEATLY AND ACCURATELY CUT OUT DESIRED LENGTH OF PIPE FOR INSERTION OF PROPER FITTING, USING COUPLINGS TO HOLD IT FIRMLY IN PLACE.
- 12. WHENEVER A SANITARY/COMBINED SEWER CROSSES UNDER A WATERMAIN, THE MINIMUM VERTICAL DISTANCE FROM THE TOP OF THE SEWER TO THE BOTTOM OF THE WATERMAIN SHALL BE 18 INCHES.
